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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
15 Educational Television Authority from any monies not otherwise
16 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
18 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be
19 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma
20 Educational Television Authority.

21 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
22 Oklahoma Educational Television Authority shall budget all funds in
23 the following categories and amounts:

5 The Authority shall develop outcome-based performance measures
6 for each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Oklahoma Educational Television Authority by law shall be
10 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
11 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
12 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Educational
13 Television Authority for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall
14 be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
15 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
16 capital and special projects except as may be authorized pursuant to
17 the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

21 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
22 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
24 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).

1 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
2 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
3 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
4 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
5 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
6 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
7 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
8 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
9 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
10 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
11 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
12 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
13 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
14 approved by the Office of State Finance.

15 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

16 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
