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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. The Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools is
15 hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30,
16 2010, from the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools
17 Revolving Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of _____ Dollars
18 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
19 imposed upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools by
20 law.

21 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
22 Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools shall budget all funds
23 in the following categories and amounts:

1 Licensing/Investigative

3 The Board shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
4 each budget category.

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
7 upon the Oklahoma Board of Private Vocational Schools by law shall
8 be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
9 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly

10 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Board of
11 Private Vocational Schools, for the fiscal year ending June 30,
12 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on
13 full-time-equivalent employees except as may be authorized pursuant
14 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
15 Statutes:

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18 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
19 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
20 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
21 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
22 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
23 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
24 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall

1 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
2 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
3 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
4 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
5 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
6 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
7 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
8 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
9 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
10 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
11 approved by the Office of State Finance.

12 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

13 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
