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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Board of
15 Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics from any
16 monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of
17 the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum
18 of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be
19 necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Board of Trustees
20 of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law.

21 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act,
22 the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) shall be expended
23 for the purpose of developing and offering pilot outreach programs

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1 in science and mathematics as directed in Section 1210.404 of Title
2 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

3 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Board
4 of Trustees of the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics shall
5 budget all funds in the following categories and amounts:

13 The Board of Trustees shall develop outcome-based performance
14 measures for each budget category.

15 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Oklahoma School of Science and Mathematics by law shall be
18 set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed
19 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly
20 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma School of
21 Science and Mathematics for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
22 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
23 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures
24 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized

1 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes:

5 SECTION 5. Students who are enrolled in a consolidated school
6 district shall be eligible to apply to attend regional pilot
7 outreach programs in science and mathematics as directed in Section
8 1210.404 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes if all or part of the
9 consolidated school district is served by the technology center
10 school district.

11 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
12 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
13 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
14 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
15 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
16 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
17 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
18 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
19 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
20 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
21 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
22 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
23 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
24 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after

1 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
2 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
3 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
4 approved by the Office of State Finance.

5 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

6 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
