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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
15 Public Safety from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so
18 much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon
19 the Department of Public Safety by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
21 Department of Public Safety shall budget all funds in the following
22 categories and amounts:

11 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
12 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
13 upon the Department of Public Safety by law shall be set by the
14 Director. The salary of the Director shall not exceed _____
15 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2010. The Department of Public Safety for the
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
18 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
19 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
20 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
21 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

1 SECTION 4. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
2 Public Safety by Section 1 of this act, Twenty-six Thousand Dollars
3 (\$26,000.00) shall be expended for the services of a Capitol Patrol
4 Officer to the Oklahoma Workers' Compensation Court pursuant to a
5 contract between the Department of Public Safety and the Oklahoma
6 Workers' Compensation Court.

7 SECTION 5. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
8 Public Safety by Section 1 of this act, Sixty-five Thousand Dollars
9 (\$65,000.00) shall be expended for the annual lease payment of the
10 Clinton/Sherman Industrial Complex.

11 SECTION 6. The Department of Public Safety is hereby authorized
12 to expend _____ Dollars (\$0.00) from the Department of Public
13 Safety Patrol Vehicle Revolving Fund for the fiscal year ending June
14 30, 2010, for the purchase of patrol vehicles and aircraft and
15 equipping those vehicles and aircraft.

16 SECTION 7. The Department of Public Safety, for the fiscal year
17 ending June 30, 2010, shall have one Patrol Academy consisting of no
18 fewer than thirty cadets.

19 SECTION 8. Of the monies appropriated to the Department of
20 Public Safety by Section 1 of this act, not more than _____
21 Dollars (\$0.00) shall be transferred to the Oklahoma Climatological
22 Survey, under the direction and supervision of the Board of Regents
23 of the University of Oklahoma, for the use of the Survey to perform
24 its duties as prescribed by law.

1 SECTION 9. Appropriations made by this act, not including
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
5 Funds budgeted for FY-10 may be encumbered only through June 30,
6 2010, and must be expended by November 15, 2010. Any funds
7 remaining after November 15, 2010, and not budgeted for FY-11, shall
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June
10 30, 2011. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2011, shall lapse
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-10, and not required to pay
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-11, after
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
17 from the FY-10 budget work program and after such revision has been
18 approved by the Office of State Finance.

19 SECTION 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

20 SECTION 11. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
