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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court
14 from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue
15 Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
16 the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may
17 be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Supreme Court or
18 the Court of Civil Appeals by law.

19 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court
20 from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue
21 Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
22 the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) to transfer to the
23 Legal Services Revolving Fund created pursuant to subsection G of
24 Section 921.1 of Title 12 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 SECTION 3. There is hereby appropriated to the Supreme Court
2 for deposit in the Supreme Court Revolving Fund from any monies not
3 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
4 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of
5 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) for expenditures authorized by
6 Section 1310.1 of Title 20 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

7 SECTION 4. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
8 Supreme Court shall budget all funds in the following categories and
9 amounts:

15 SECTION 5. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Supreme Court by law shall be set by the Supreme Court
18 Justices by majority vote.

19 SECTION 6. The duties and compensation of employees, not
20 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
21 upon the Court of Civil Appeals by law shall be set by the Court of
22 Civil Appeals, subject to the approval of the Supreme Court.

23 SECTION 7. The Supreme Court and the Court of Civil Appeals for
24 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the

1 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees,
2 excluding active retired judges, and expenditures, excluding
3 expenditures for capital and special projects and excluding lawful
4 expenditures from the State Judicial Fund, except as may be
5 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of
6 the Oklahoma Statutes:

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10 SECTION 8. Appropriations made by this act, not including
11 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
12 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 (hereafter FY-10) or may be
13 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11).
14 Any remaining cash balance on November 15, 2010, may be transferred
15 to the Supreme Court Administrative Revolving Fund as needed.

16 SECTION 9. Of the monies appropriated to the Supreme Court by
17 Sections 113, 114 and 115 of Enrolled House Bill No. 2276 of the 2nd
18 Session of the 51st Oklahoma Legislature, not including
19 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, any remaining cash
20 balance on November 15, 2009, may be transferred to the Supreme
21 Court Administrative Revolving Fund as needed.

22 SECTION 10. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

23 SECTION 11. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
24 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
