9 An Act relating to attorneys; prohibiting attorney
10 and counselor from deducting or withholding certain
11 monies for the purpose of contributing to certain
12 funds, campaigns, or candidates; providing for
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4.1 of Title 5, unless there is
17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 An attorney and counselor shall not deduct or withhold any
19 portion of a judgment from a court of law, settlement proceeds of a
20 client, or any monies held in trust for a client for the purpose of
21 donating or contributing funds or monies to a political fund,
22 political action committee, campaign of any kind, or candidate for
23 state, federal or local office.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
