8 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending
9 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1288, which relates to the
10 purchase of firearms by Oklahoma residents from
11 contiguous states; deleting requirement that certain
12 purchases be made in a state contiguous to Oklahoma;
13 providing statutory references; and declaring an
14 emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1288, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1288. ~~(a) A.~~ Residents of the State of Oklahoma may
19 purchase rifles, shotguns, ammunition, cartridge and shotgun shell
20 handloading components and equipment from a dealer licensed in a
21 state ~~contiguous to the State of~~ other than Oklahoma, ~~provided that~~
22 ~~such residents conform to the applicable.~~ This authorization is
23 enacted in conformance with the provisions of the Federal Gun
24 Control Act of 1968, and regulations thereunder, as administered by
the United States Secretary of the Treasury, Section 922(b)(3) of

1 Title 18 of the United States Code and provided further that such
2 residents conform to the provisions of law applicable to such
3 purchase in the State of Oklahoma and ~~in the contiguous~~ state in
4 which the purchase is made.

5 ~~(b) B.~~ Residents of a state ~~contiguous to the State of~~ other
6 than Oklahoma may purchase rifles, shotguns, ammunition, cartridge
7 and shotgun shell handloading components and equipment from a dealer
8 licensed in the State of Oklahoma, ~~provided that such residents~~
9 ~~conform to the applicable.~~ This authorization is enacted in
10 conformance with the provisions of ~~the Gun Control Act of 1968,~~ and
11 ~~regulations thereunder, as administered by the United States~~
12 ~~Secretary of the Treasury~~ Section 922(b)(3) of Title 18 of the
13 United States Code and provided further that such residents conform
14 to the provisions of law applicable to such purchase in the State of
15 Oklahoma and in the state in which such persons reside.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
