7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 1210.509, which relates to the administration
9 of certain tests; providing that school counselors
shall not be required to coordinate certain tests;
and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1210.509, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 1210.509 A. The Department shall provide in-service
16 training for local school personnel who administer tests required by
17 the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act, Section 1210.505 et seq. of
18 this title.

19 B. The Board shall require the company or companies providing
20 tests required by the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act, Section
21 1210.505 et seq. of this title, to submit summary reports of the
22 results by school district to the Department and the respective
23 local school district. Individualized results of the test shall be
24 made available by the local school district to the classroom

1 teachers who instruct the students in the academic areas tested. In
2 every year, prior to the convening of the Legislature, the Board
3 shall give a summary report on the testing results to the Governor,
4 the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President Pro
5 Tempore of the Senate.

6 C. School counselors certified by the Department shall not be
7 required by local school districts to coordinate tests required by
8 the Oklahoma School Testing Program Act.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2009.
