12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.451 of Title 74, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. Except as otherwise provided by this section, each state
17 agency, board, commission or other entity organized within the
18 executive department of state government shall use the Trip
19 Optimizer system of the Department of Central Services in computing
20 the optimum method and cost for travel by state employees using a
21 motor vehicle.

22 B. The provisions of this section shall be used to determine
23 the most cost-effective method of travel by motor vehicles, whether
24 such vehicles are owned by the agency, leased by the agency or by

1 the employee, and shall be applicable for purposes of determining
2 the maximum authorized amount of any travel reimbursement for
3 employees of such agencies related to vehicle usage.

4 C. An agency, as defined in subsection A of this section, that
5 employs persons who use personal vehicles as part of their regular
6 duties and who are reimbursed for travel expenses by the agency
7 shall not be required to utilize the Trip Optimizer system with
8 regard to the travel expenses of such employees.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
