7 An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001,
8 Section 6-101.23, as amended by Section 1, Chapter
9 25, O.S.L. 2009 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 6-
10 101.23), which relates to the application of the
11 Teacher Due Process Act of 1990; changing number of
12 semesters a teacher may be hired on temporary
13 contract; deleting certain exception; providing an
14 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 6-101.23, as
17 amended by Section 1, Chapter 25, O.S.L. 2009 (70 O.S. Supp. 2009,
18 Section 6-101.23), is amended to read as follows:

19 A. The dismissal, suspension and nonreemployment provisions of
20 the Teacher Due Process Act of 1990 shall not apply to:

- 21 1. Substitute teachers;
- 22 2. Adult education teachers; and
- 23 3. Teachers who are employed on temporary contracts.

24 B. The dismissal and suspension provisions of the Teacher Due
Process Act of 1990 shall apply to teachers who are employed on
temporary contracts for a complete school year and to teachers who

1 are employed in positions fully funded by federal or private
2 categorical grants, except that such teachers shall be employed only
3 for the duration of the temporary contract or the grant.

4 C. The evaluation provisions in Sections 6-101.10 and 6-101.11
5 of this title and in the Teacher Due Process Act of 1990 shall apply
6 to teachers who are employed on temporary contracts for a complete
7 school year and to teachers who are employed in positions fully
8 funded by federal or private categorical grants, except that such
9 teachers shall be employed only for the duration of the temporary
10 contract or the grant.

11 D. Teachers other than those specifically excepted in
12 subsection A of this section who are employed on contracts shall be
13 afforded all substantive and procedural rights set forth in the
14 Teacher Due Process Act of 1990 including the dismissal, suspension,
15 and nonreemployment provisions applicable to probationary or career
16 teachers as defined in Section 6-101.3 of this title.

17 E. On and after the effective date of this act any teacher who
18 has worked a complete school year under a temporary contract in a
19 school district shall be granted a year of service credit toward
20 career status in that district.

21 F. No teacher shall be hired on a temporary contract by a
22 school district for more than ~~three~~ four semesters, except for a:

1 1. Teacher hired to replace a teacher who is on an approved
2 leave of absence and who is expected to return to employment with
3 the school district; or

4 2. Teacher who is a retired member of the Teachers' Retirement
5 System of Oklahoma; ~~or~~

6 ~~3. Licensed teacher who is hired on a temporary contract in a
7 resident teacher position for a complete school year, who may be
8 hired by the school district for one (1) additional complete school
9 year on a temporary contract for the school year immediately after
10 the resident year.~~

11 G. No teacher shall be offered a temporary contract with a
12 school district without a full written disclosure at the time a
13 position is offered by the administration of the school district
14 which sets forth the terms and conditions of the temporary contract.
15 In the event the school district fails to provide such written
16 disclosure, the teacher shall be considered as employed on a
17 continuing contract basis.

18 H. On and after the effective date of this act no teacher who
19 is employed on a continuing contract basis by a school district
20 shall be reemployed on a temporary contract in that school district.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24

1 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
2 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
