7 An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S.
8 2001, Section 3921, which relates to the termination
9 of certain entities; providing for termination of
10 task forces or similar advisory entities; prescribing
11 time period for termination; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3921, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 3921. A. 1. Any joint resolution or bill enacted
17 after February 1, 1993, creating or establishing advisory bodies
18 including, but not limited to, task forces, boards, commissions, and
19 councils, which creation or establishment is not codified in the
20 Oklahoma Statutes, shall terminate the first day of the first
21 regular session of the next Oklahoma Legislature unless the joint
22 resolution or bill specifies an earlier or later termination date.

23 2. Any advisory bodies created by bill or joint resolution
24 prior to February 1, 1993, which creation or establishment is not

1 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes, shall be terminated unless the
2 advisory body is codified in the next decennial compilation of
3 Oklahoma laws.

4 B. 1. Effective January 1, 1994, except as otherwise provided
5 by this subsection, advisory bodies including, but not limited to,
6 task forces, boards, commissions and councils created or established
7 by simple resolutions or concurrent resolutions passed by the
8 Legislature or either house thereof shall terminate the first day of
9 the first regular session of the next Oklahoma Legislature, unless
10 such simple or concurrent resolution specifies an earlier
11 termination date.

12 2. Any such advisory body created prior to January 1, 1991, by
13 a simple or concurrent resolution passed by the Legislature or
14 either house thereof is hereby terminated.

15 C. If a task force or similar advisory body created pursuant to
16 a codified section of law does not conduct at least one meeting or
17 issue its final report within three (3) years from the date upon
18 which the section of law creating the task force or similar advisory
19 body becomes effective, the task force or advisory body shall cease
20 to have any authority to conduct any business and shall be
21 considered terminated by operation of law at the expiration of the
22 three-year period.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
