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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Commissioners of  
15 the Land Office from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
16 Commissioners of the Land Office Fund of the State Treasury for the  
17 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
18 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
19 the duties imposed upon the Commissioners of the Land Office by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
21 Commissioners of the Land Office shall budget all funds in the  
22 following categories and amounts:

5 The Department shall develop outcome-based performance measures  
6 for each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
9 upon the Department of the Commissioners of the Land Office by law  
10 shall be set by the Secretary of the Department. The salary of the  
11 Secretary shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
12 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.

13 The salary of the Assistant Secretary shall not exceed ninety  
14 percent (90%) of the Secretary's salary per annum, payable monthly  
15 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011. The Department of the  
16 Commissioners of the Land Office for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
17 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
18 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding  
19 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
20 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
21 the Oklahoma Statutes:

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1           SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
2 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
3 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be  
4 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).  
5 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
6 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds  
7 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall  
8 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
9 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June  
10 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse  
11 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
12 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
13 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay  
14 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after  
15 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
16 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
17 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been  
18 approved by the Office of State Finance.

19           SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

20           SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
21 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
