13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election  
15 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General  
16 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June  
17 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof  
18 as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the State  
19 Election Board by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the State  
21 Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories  
22 and amounts:

5 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
6 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
7 upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the State  
8 Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the State Election  
9 Board shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per  
10 annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.  
11 The State Election Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011,  
12 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-  
13 time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures  
14 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized  
15 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the  
16 Oklahoma Statutes:

20 SECTION 4. The appropriation made by this act shall not be  
21 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for  
22 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)  
23 months from the date this act is approved.

24 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

1 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
2 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
