13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State  
15 Senate from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General  
16 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June  
17 30, 2011, the following amount, or so much thereof as may be  
18 necessary to pay monthly salaries, per diem, and expenses of the  
19 members of the Senate and the salaries of its employees, and such  
20 contingent expenses as may be ordered paid therefrom, including the  
21 preparation and printing of the journals and calendars of the  
22 Senate, and including the preparation and printing of the permanent  
23 journals thereof, in accordance with the following amount herein set  
24 forth:

1 For expenses of personal services  
2 (including retirement and insurance  
3 costs), including those of members, and  
4 employees of the Senate, and expenses  
5 of maintenance and operation, including  
6 travel expenses, supplies, materials,  
7 printing, equipment, and printing of  
8 permanent journals and for the  
9 renovation and modification of the  
10 Senate area \$0.00

11 SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be  
12 subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for  
13 encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30)  
14 months from the date this act is approved.

15 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

16 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
