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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
15 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry from any monies not
16 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State
17 Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____
18 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform
19 the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture,
20 Food, and Forestry by law.

21 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
22 Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry shall budget
23 all funds in the following categories and amounts:

20 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
21 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry by
23 law shall be set by the Commissioner. The salary of the
24 Commissioner shall not exceed _____ Dollars

1 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June
2 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
3 Forestry, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject
4 to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent
5 employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and
6 special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the
7 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

14 SECTION 4. Appropriations made by this act, not including
15 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
17 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
18 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
19 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
20 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall
21 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
22 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
23 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
24 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.

1 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
2 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
3 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
4 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
5 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
6 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
7 approved by the Office of State Finance.

8 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

9 SECTION 6. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
