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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma
15 Conservation Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated
16 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
17 year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or
18 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. The Oklahoma Conservation Commission is authorized
21 to expend an amount not to exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) from
22 the Rural Economic Action Plan Water Projects Fund from the gross
23 production tax, as apportioned by Section 1004 of Title 68 of the
24 Oklahoma Statutes, to be transferred to the Oklahoma Conservation

1 Commission Cost-Share Revolving Fund ("210 Fund"), to perform the
2 duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law.

3 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the
4 Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall budget all funds in the
5 following categories and amounts:

15 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not
16 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
17 upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law shall be set by the
18 Executive Director of the Commission. The salary of the Executive
19 Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall be set by the
20 Commission. The Oklahoma Conservation Commission for the fiscal
21 year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
22 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
23 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
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1 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
2 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

8 SECTION 5. Of the full-time-equivalent employee positions
9 authorized in this act, _____ (0) shall be filled contingent upon
10 procurement of federal funds for the Abandoned Mine Lands program
11 and _____ (0) shall be filled contingent upon procurement of
12 federal funds for the Water Quality 319 Program. Such full-time-
13 equivalent employee positions supported by federal funds shall be
14 terminated upon the discontinuation of federal funds. Such full-
15 time-equivalent employee positions shall be unclassified and, except
16 for leave regulations, shall be exempt from the rules of the Merit
17 System of Personnel Administration.

18 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
19 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
20 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be
21 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).
22 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,
23 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds
24 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall

1 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
2 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June
3 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse
4 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
5 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
6 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay
7 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after
8 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
9 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
10 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been
11 approved by the Office of State Finance.

12 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

13 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
14 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
15 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
16 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
