13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of  
15 Labor from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General  
16 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June  
17 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof  
18 as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
19 Department of Labor by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
21 Department of Labor shall budget all funds in the following  
22 categories and amounts:

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
10 upon the Department of Labor by law shall be set by the Commissioner  
11 of Labor. The Department of Labor for the fiscal year ending June  
12 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
13 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding  
14 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
15 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
16 the Oklahoma Statutes:

20 SECTION 4. Of the \_\_\_\_\_ (0) full-time-equivalent employee  
21 positions authorized for the Department of Labor in this act, \_\_\_\_\_  
22 (0) full-time-equivalent employee positions shall be contingent upon  
23 the procurement of federal funds and shall be terminated when  
24 federal support of those positions is discontinued.

1 SECTION 5. A. By February 1, 2011, the Department of Labor  
2 shall submit an annual report to the President Pro Tempore of the  
3 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives detailing the  
4 amount per agency of all state, federal and local funds received,  
5 directly or indirectly, for asbestos abatement, the projects  
6 completed per agency, the number of agency employees used in the  
7 programs, and the projected needs for the next succeeding fiscal  
8 year.

9 B. The Department of Central Services, the Department of  
10 Corrections, the Department of Human Services and the Oklahoma State  
11 Regents for Higher Education and any other appropriate state agency  
12 involved in asbestos abatement shall cooperate with the Department  
13 of Labor to provide the information required pursuant to the  
14 provisions of this section.

15 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
16 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
17 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011 (hereafter FY-11) or may be  
18 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 (hereafter FY-12).  
19 Funds budgeted for FY-11 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
20 2011, and must be expended by November 15, 2011. Any funds  
21 remaining after November 15, 2011, and not budgeted for FY-12, shall  
22 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
23 year. Funds budgeted for FY-12 may be encumbered only through June  
24 30, 2012. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2012, shall lapse

1 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
2 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
3 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-11, and not required to pay  
4 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-12, after  
5 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
6 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
7 from the FY-11 budget work program and after such revision has been  
8 approved by the Office of State Finance.

9 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

10 SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
