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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Water  
15 Resources Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
16 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
17 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much  
18 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the  
19 Oklahoma Water Resources Board by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
21 Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall budget all funds in the  
22 following categories and amounts:

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
9 upon the Oklahoma Water Resources Board by law shall be set by the  
10 Oklahoma Water Resources Board. The salary of the Executive  
11 Director of the Oklahoma Water Resources Board shall not exceed  
12 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal  
13 year ending June 30, 2011. The Oklahoma Water Resources Board for  
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the  
15 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
16 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
17 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
18 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
