8 An Act relating to firearms; amending 19 O.S. 2001,  
9 Section 215.29, which relates to the carrying of  
10 firearms by district attorneys; authorizing assistant  
11 district attorneys to carry firearms under certain  
12 circumstances; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 215.29, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 215.29 A. A district attorney may carry a firearm on  
17 his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for personal  
18 protection if ~~he~~ the person has successfully completed an approved  
19 course of firearm training conducted by a state certified firearms  
20 instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms  
21 training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education  
22 and Training.

23 B. At the discretion of the district attorney, the district  
24 attorney may allow an assistant district attorney to carry a firearm

1 on his or her person anywhere in the state to use only for personal  
2 protection if the person has successfully completed an approved  
3 course of firearm training conducted by a state-certified firearms  
4 instructor which meets the minimum requirements for firearms  
5 training as set forth by the Council on Law Enforcement Education  
6 and Training.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
