8 An Act relating to game and fish; amending Section 1,
9 Chapter 130, O.S.L. 2002 (29 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section
10 4-138), which relates to the Blue River Conservation
11 Passport; changing the name of the Passport;
12 expanding requirement for Passport to certain
13 designated areas of land; authorizing the Wildlife
14 Conservation Commission to designate lands; and
15 modifying fee for annual Passport.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 130, O.S.L.
18 2002 (29 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 4-138), is amended to read as
19 follows:

20 Section 4-138. A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission may
21 establish a special use permit to be designated the "~~Blue River~~
22 Wildlife Conservation Passport". The Passport shall be required of
23 all persons not otherwise exempt as provided for in subsection C of
24 this section, who enter or use ~~the Blue River Public Fishing and~~
Hunting Area land owned by the Commission and that has been
designated by the Commission as requiring a Passport.

1 B. The Commission may establish and assess an annual fee of not
2 more than One Dollar (\$1.00) above the cost of an annual resident
3 hunting or fishing license for the Passport. Each person, not
4 otherwise exempt as provided for in subsection C of this section,
5 entering or using ~~the Blue River Public Fishing and Hunting Area~~ a
6 designated area of land shall be required to have a Passport in
7 their possession while in the area.

8 C. The following persons shall be exempt from the Passport
9 requirements of this section:

10 1. All persons who possess a valid Oklahoma annual or
11 combination resident fishing or hunting license, an annual
12 nonresident fishing or hunting license, a lifetime resident or
13 nonresident fishing, hunting, or combination license, a senior
14 citizen lifetime fishing or hunting license, or a disability fishing
15 or hunting license;

16 2. Legal residents of Oklahoma who are under eighteen (18)
17 years of age on the first day of the current calendar year; and

18 3. Students and instructors participating in bona fide
19 educational tours or activities sponsored or organized by an
20 educational institution or entity or any other organized event
21 sanctioned in advance by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife
22 Conservation. Sponsors of such activities shall provide notice of
23 the date and number of persons participating in the activity to the
