8 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
9 2001, Section 14-105, which relates to loads on
10 vehicles; making an exception for vehicles loaded
with certain product; and providing an effective
date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 14-105, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 14-105. ~~(a)~~ A. No vehicle shall be driven or moved on
17 any highway unless such vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to
18 prevent any of its load from dropping, sifting, leaking, blowing or
19 otherwise escaping therefrom, except that sand may be dropped for
20 the purpose of securing traction, or water or other substances may
21 be sprinkled on a roadway in cleaning or maintaining such roadway.

22 ~~(b)~~ B. No person shall operate on any highway any vehicle with
23 any load unless said load and any covering thereon is securely
24 fastened so as to prevent said covering or load from becoming loose,

1 detached or in any manner a hazard to other users of the highway.
2 Any vehicle loaded with sand, cinders, or other loose material
3 susceptible to blowing or otherwise escaping shall have such load
4 covered so as to prevent the blowing or escaping of said load from
5 the vehicle.

6 ~~(e)~~ C. This section shall not apply to trucks loaded with
7 livestock, poultry or agricultural products only except baled
8 agricultural products, provided that any such truck shall be so
9 constructed or loaded as to prevent such livestock or poultry from
10 escaping therefrom.

11 D. The provisions of this section shall not apply to any
12 vehicle loaded with hay if the vehicle is not traveling on state
13 highways, turnpikes or any segment of the National System of
14 Interstate and Defense Highways.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
