8 An Act relating to economic development; creating the
9 Task Force on the Oklahoma Quality Investment Act;
10 providing for membership; requiring organizational
11 meeting; providing for selection of chair and
12 cochair; prescribing quorum requirement; providing
13 for inapplicability of Oklahoma Open Meeting Act;
14 prescribing requirement for meeting notices;
15 providing for travel reimbursement; specifying
16 reimbursement method for legislator members;
17 providing for staff assistance; prescribing scope of
18 inquiry by Task Force; requiring final report;
19 specifying date of report; providing for termination
20 of Task Force; providing for codification; and
21 declaring an emergency.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

23 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
24 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4211 of Title 68, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. There is hereby created the Task Force on the Oklahoma
Quality Investment Act.

1 B. The Task Force shall be composed of nine (9) members to be
2 appointed as follows:

- 3 a. three members to be appointed by the Governor,
- 4 b. three members to be appointed by the Speaker of the
5 Oklahoma House of Representatives,
- 6 c. three members to be appointed by the President Pro
7 Tempore of the State Senate.

8 C. Members of the Task Force shall serve at the pleasure of the
9 appointing authority. Vacancies in a position shall be filled in
10 the same manner as the original appointment.

11 D. The Task Force shall hold an organizational meeting not
12 later than September 30, 2010.

13 E. The Task Force shall select from among its membership a
14 chair and cochair.

15 F. A quorum of the members present at a meeting of the Task
16 Force shall be sufficient to conduct any business or to take any
17 action authorized or required.

18 G. The Task Force shall be exempt from the Oklahoma Open
19 Meeting Act, but shall provide a reasonable notice of its meetings
20 at least seven (7) days prior to a meeting. The notice shall be
21 posted electronically on the website of the Oklahoma House of
22 Representatives or the Oklahoma State Senate or both. A notice may
23 be posted at such location or locations within the Oklahoma State
24 Capitol as the Task Force may direct.

1 H. Travel reimbursement for members of the Task Force who are
2 legislators shall be made pursuant to Section 456 of Title 74 of the
3 Oklahoma Statutes. Travel reimbursement for other members of the
4 Task Force shall be made by the respective appointing authorities
5 pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.

6 I. Staff assistance for the Task Force shall be provided by the
7 staff of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Oklahoma
8 State Senate.

9 J. The Task Force shall be exempt from the Oklahoma Open
10 Records Act.

11 K. The Task Force shall examine the Oklahoma Quality Investment
12 Act including, but not limited to:

13 1. The prior use of the incentive created by the Oklahoma
14 Quality Investment Act;

15 2. Whether the Oklahoma Quality Investment Act has been an
16 effective incentive;

17 3. Possible changes in the Oklahoma Quality Investment Act to
18 enhance and improve its effectiveness; and

19 4. Such other features or issues related to the Oklahoma
20 Quality Investment Act as the Task Force may deem to be relevant.

21 L. The Task Force shall make a final report containing any
22 recommendations for changes in the Oklahoma Quality Investment Act
23 to the Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of

1 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
2 Senate not later than January 31, 2011.

3 M. The Task Force shall terminate by operation of law on
4 February 1, 2011.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
