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9 An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending  
10 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.13, which relates to the  
11 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act; making certain information  
12 confidential; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.13, is  
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 1290.13

17 AUTOMATIC LISTING OF LICENSES

18 The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation shall maintain an  
19 automated listing of all persons issued a concealed handgun license  
20 in this state pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-  
21 Defense Act, ~~Section 1290.1 et seq. of this title,~~ and all  
22 subsequent suspended or revoked licenses. Information from the  
23 automated listing shall only be available to a law enforcement  
24 officer or law enforcement agency upon request for law enforcement

1 purposes. Information from the automated listing including, but not  
2 limited to, the name, address, date of birth, photograph,  
3 fingerprints or other pertinent information of the applicant shall  
4 be kept confidential and shall not be disclosed to the public. The  
5 Bureau shall also maintain for each applicant the original  
6 application or a copy of the original application form and any  
7 subsequent renewal application forms together with the photographs,  
8 fingerprints and other pertinent information on the applicant which  
9 shall be confidential, except to law enforcement officers or law  
10 enforcement agencies in the performance of their duties. To  
11 facilitate the Bureau's administration of the Oklahoma Self-Defense  
12 Act, all licensees shall maintain a current mailing address where  
13 the licensee may receive certified mail. The licensee shall within  
14 thirty (30) days of a change of name or address inform the Bureau of  
15 such change.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
