WHEREAS, Oklahoma veterans have served this country and have
dedicated themselves to the defense of America; and

1 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma honors veterans with Veterans
2 Day; and

3 WHEREAS, many Oklahoma veterans are not able to enjoy this day
4 in their honor because their employers require their presence on
5 Veterans Day; and

6 WHEREAS, Oklahoma employers could demonstrate their respect for
7 veterans by allowing them to celebrate Veterans Day with a paid
