A Concurrent Resolution remembering the courage and
sacrifice of Rebecca Anderson; proclaiming Rebecca
Anderson Nurse of the Day in perpetuity on April 19
each year; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, as we come to the time to commemorate all of those
individuals who lost their lives in the tragedy of the bombing of

1 the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building on April 19, 1995, it is
2 especially fitting, since April is organ and tissue donor awareness
3 month, to recognize the sacrifice of Rebecca Anderson, a nurse who
4 rushed to the Murrah Building after the bombing to render aid; and

5 WHEREAS, Rebecca Anderson, an LPN who lived the code of her
6 profession, acted courageously to provide assistance to the injured
7 without thought of her own safety; and

8 WHEREAS, sadly, Rebecca was struck by falling debris at the bomb
9 site and ultimately the injury took her life; and

10 WHEREAS, this sacrifice alone would speak to her dedication to
11 helping those in need of medical attention, but her sacrifice did
12 not stop there. She later became a kidney and heart donor, thereby
13 saving the lives of three people; and

14 WHEREAS, we should never forget the unselfish acts of this
15 wonderful person, who not only lost her life serving others, but
16 gave the ultimate gift of life to others through organ donation.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
18 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE
19 CONCURRING THEREIN:

20 THAT in remembrance of the courageous acts of Rebecca Anderson
21 after the bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building on April
22 19, 1995, her sacrifice and her gift of life to others, Rebecca
23 Anderson is hereby named "Nurse of the Day" in perpetuity on April
24 19 each year.
