13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE  
14 1ST SESSION OF THE 52ND OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

15 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for  
16 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,  
17 the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article XI of the  
18 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

19 Section 3. The interest and income of the permanent school  
20 fund, the net income from the leasing of public lands which have  
21 been or may be granted by the United States to the State for the use  
22 and benefit of the common schools, together with ~~any~~ revenues  
23 derived from taxes authorized to be levied for such purposes, and  
24 any other sums which may be added thereto by law, shall be used and

1 applied each year for the benefit of the common schools of the  
2 State, and shall be, for this purpose, apportioned among and between  
3 all the several common school districts of the State in proportion  
4 to the school population of the several districts, and no part of  
5 the fund shall ever be diverted from this purpose, or used for any  
6 other purpose than the support and maintenance of common schools for  
7 the equal benefit of all the people of the State.

8 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional  
9 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in  
10 the following form:

13 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

14 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends  
15 Section 3 of Article 11. It makes clear the use of revenue is  
16 to be used for the benefit of the common schools of the State.

17 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
