13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Merit
15 Protection Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated
16 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
17 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars
18 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties
19 imposed upon the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
21 Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission shall budget all funds in the
22 following categories and amounts:

6 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
7 each budget category.

8 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
9 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
10 upon the Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission by law shall be set by
11 the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director of the
12 Oklahoma Merit Protection Commission shall not exceed
13 _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for
14 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Merit Protection
15 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be
16 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-
17 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for
18 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant
19 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
20 Statutes:
