7 An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
8 Investigation; authorizing sale of property;  
9 providing for noncodification; providing an effective  
10 date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
13 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

14 A. On or after September 1, 2009, the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
15 Investigation is authorized to sell the following described property  
16 in Oklahoma County in whole or in part:

17 Legal Description of property to be sold.

18 A tract of land in the NW/4 of Section 24, Township 12 North,  
19 Range 3 West of the Indian Meridian, Oklahoma County, Oklahoma,  
20 described as:

21 COMMENCING at the northwest corner of said NW/4;

22 Thence N89°30'53"E on the north line of said NW/4 (the bearing  
23 upon which this description is based) a distance of 618.00 feet  
24 to the Point of Beginning;

1 Thence continuing N89°30'53"E on North line of said NW/4 a  
2 distance of 252.00 feet;

3 Thence S00°13'08"E parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a  
4 distance of 280.00 feet;

5 Thence S89°30'53"W parallel with the North line of said NW/4 a  
6 distance of 360.00 feet;

7 Thence N00°13'08"W parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a  
8 distance of 161.65 feet;

9 Thence N89°30'53"E parallel with the North line of said NW/4 a  
10 distance of 108.00 feet;

11 Thence N00°13'08"W parallel with the West line of said NW/4 a  
12 distance of 118.35 feet to the Point of Beginning;

13 The above description has a gross area of 2.02 acres more or  
14 less subject to easements and rights-of-way of record.

15 Such sale shall be contingent upon submission of the sale of this  
16 property for public auction or sealed bids by the Oklahoma State  
17 Bureau of Investigation in compliance with Section 129.4 of Title 74  
18 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

19 B. The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation is directed to  
20 transfer any monies received from the sale of the property described  
21 in subsection A of this section to the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
22 Investigation to the OSBI Revolving Fund established by Section  
23 150.19a of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2009.
