12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
14 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall budget all funds in the following
15 categories and amounts:

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the Oklahoma Tax Commission by law shall be set by the Oklahoma
9 Tax Commission. The Oklahoma Tax Commission for the fiscal year
10 ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary
11 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
12 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
13 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
14 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
