12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Office
14 of the State Treasurer shall budget all funds in the following
15 categories and amounts:

1 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
2 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

4 State Treasurer. The Office of the State Treasurer for the fiscal
5 year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
6 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
7 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
8 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
9 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
