12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 199.14, as
14 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 86, O.S.L. 2006 (59 O.S. Supp.
15 2009, Section 199.14), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 199.14 A. The following fees shall be charged by the
17 State Board of Cosmetology:

21 B. In addition to the fees specified in subsection A of this
22 section, the Board shall charge a total penalty of Ten Dollars
23 (\$10.00), as provided for in Section 199.10 of this title.

1 C. Any person licensed as an advanced operator prior to July 1,
2 1985, may renew the advanced cosmetologist license annually by
3 payment of the fee required by this section and by being in
4 compliance with the rules promulgated by the State Board of
5 Cosmetology.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

7 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
8 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
9 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
10 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
