12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the State
14 Department of Health shall budget all funds in the following
15 categories and amounts:

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the State Department of Health by law shall be set by the State
9 Commissioner of Health. The salary of the Commissioner shall not
10 exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the
11 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The State Department of Health
12 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the
13 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
14 and expenditures, excluding expenditures for capital and special
15 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
16 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
