7 An Act relating to wildlife; amending 29 O.S. 2001,  
8 Section 4-114, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter  
9 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp. 2009, Section 4-114),  
10 which relates to hunting and fishing license;  
11 authorizing persons under a certain age to purchase  
12 certain licenses during a certain period of time;  
13 providing for forfeiture under certain circumstances;  
14 and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2001, Section 4-114, as  
17 last amended by Section 16, Chapter 16, O.S.L. 2006 (29 O.S. Supp.  
18 2009, Section 4-114), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 4-114. A. All legal residents who have resided in the  
20 state for at least six (6) months may purchase lifetime fishing  
21 licenses, lifetime hunting licenses or lifetime combination  
22 hunting/fishing licenses from the State Wildlife Conservation  
23 Director.

24 B. 1. The fee for these licenses shall be:

1           a.    lifetime fishing license, Two Hundred Dollars

7           c.    lifetime combination hunting/fishing license, Seven

10          d.    lifetime hunting license for persons sixty (60) years  
11                                   of age or older, Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) †1

12   ~~5. Lifetime~~

13          e.    lifetime fishing license for persons sixty (60) years  
14                                   of age or older, Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) †1 and

15   ~~6. Lifetime~~

16          f.    lifetime combination hunting/fishing license for  
17                                   persons sixty (60) years of age or older, Two Hundred  
18                                   Fifteen Dollars (\$215.00).

19    2. The fee for a resident lifetime fishing license, a lifetime  
20 hunting license, or a lifetime combination hunting/fishing license  
21 for a legal resident of Oklahoma under eighteen (18) years of age  
22 may be paid for by installments not to exceed a three-year-period of  
23 time and in a manner determined by the Director. The lifetime  
24 license will only be issued and become valid upon full payment. If

1 the entire license fee is not received three (3) years from the date  
2 the application is received, any funds received shall be forfeited  
3 and will not be refunded.

4 C. Legal resident having proper certification from the United  
5 States Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor certifying  
6 that the person is a disabled veteran may purchase a disability  
7 lifetime combination hunting/fishing license from the State Wildlife  
8 Conservation Director. The fees for the license shall be as  
9 follows:

10 1. Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for veterans having a  
11 disability of less than sixty percent (60%); and

12 2. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for veterans having a  
13 disability of sixty percent (60%) or more.

14 D. The use of the licenses provided in this section are subject  
15 to those restrictions provided by statute and the regulations of the  
16 Wildlife Conservation Commission. Except as otherwise provided for  
17 in this section, the lifetime hunting license shall be in lieu of  
18 all annual hunting licenses and all special season permits.

19 E. Nonresidents may purchase a lifetime nonresident fishing  
20 license. The fee for such license shall be Two Hundred Fifty  
21 Dollars (\$250.00).

22 F. Should any lifetime license be lost or destroyed, a  
23 duplicate will be issued by the Department of Wildlife Conservation  
24 for a fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

1 G. A lifetime licensee shall not lose the privileges of such  
2 license by a subsequent transfer of residency.

3 H. 1. In addition to the fees imposed pursuant to subsections  
4 B, C and E of this section, a person purchasing a lifetime fishing,  
5 hunting or combination license shall be required to purchase a  
6 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp. ~~Each person shall have the~~  
7 ~~stamp in their possession while hunting, fishing, or taking any~~  
8 ~~wildlife.~~ The fee for the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp  
9 shall be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) which will be added to the  
10 respective lifetime license fee. The fee for the stamp shall be  
11 distributed as follows:

12 a. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) from each stamp shall be  
13 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created  
14 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used to retire  
15 the obligations and related expenses as authorized  
16 pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the Oklahoma  
17 Statutes or to purchase, lease, or purchase easements  
18 on real property to be used as public hunting,  
19 fishing, and trapping areas; and

20 b. Five Dollars (\$5.00) from each stamp shall be  
21 deposited in the Oklahoma Wildlife Land Fund, created  
22 in Section 4-141 of this title, to be used by the  
23 Commission for management of the real property  
24 acquired pursuant to Section 168.9 of Title 73 of the

1 Oklahoma Statutes or acquired with proceeds from the  
2 Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee.

3 2. The Oklahoma Wildlife Conservation Commission shall  
4 prescribe, by rule, the form, design, and manner of issuance of the  
5 Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp.

6 3. Within one (1) year of the final retirement, redemption, or  
7 defeasance of the obligations created pursuant to Section 168.9 of  
8 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife  
9 Land Stamp and Lifetime Oklahoma Wildlife Land Stamp fee  
10 requirements provided for in this subsection shall terminate.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2011.
