BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 4020, as

14

amended by Section 2, Chapter 379, O.S.L. 2004 (63 O.S. Supp. 2009,

15

Section 4020), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4020. ~~Beginning January 1, 1990, the~~ The Oklahoma Tax

Commission shall notify through the mail, or via electronic mail,

18

all persons within the state who have previous vessel or motor

19

registrations on record of the period for registration that are due

20

to be registered in July of that year. ~~Such~~ Persons choosing to

21

receive such annual notification through the mail shall be assessed

22

an annual fee of fifty cents (\$0.50), notwithstanding the provisions

23

of Section 1114.1 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, which shall

24

be used by the Tax Commission for printing and mailing of renewal

1 notifications. Members of the armed forces of the United States,  
2 the Reserve Corps of the armed forces of the United States, and the  
3 Oklahoma National Guard and their spouses eligible for the military  
4 registration fee, as provided in Section 4021 of this title, shall  
5 receive a renewal notification without payment of such fee. The  
6 printed notice shall contain all necessary information for such  
7 registration including a breakdown of all charges to be paid by the  
8 owner. The breakdown of the charges to be paid by the owner shall  
9 include the charges an owner would pay to register the vessel or  
10 motor for a one-year period and the charges an owner would pay to  
11 register the vessel or motor for a three-year period. Use of a  
12 postcard or electronic mail-type renewal notice is specifically  
13 permitted. The content and form of the notice shall also contain  
14 instructions as to the procedure for renewal upon presentation to a  
15 motor license agent or by return mail to the Tax Commission's state  
16 office. On the back of such registration notice form there shall be  
17 an explanation of the apportionment of all fees and penalties  
18 collected and their disposition. Such explanation shall include  
19 information as to all charges and fees included in the total fee or  
20 incident to the registration of a vessel or motor. If the owner  
21 chooses the option of receiving these services through the mail,  
22 either from the Commission or a motor license agent, he shall be  
23 instructed to pay the final total listed for the period of  
24 registration chosen by the owner. The Tax Commission shall provide

1 information on its public website instructing persons on the  
2 procedure for obtaining an annual notification via electronic mail,  
3 free of charge, outlining all charges and fees associated with the  
4 registration of vessels and motors, as well as an explanation of the  
5 apportionment of vessel and motor registration fees and penalties.

6 The cost of mailing shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) for titles or other  
7 forms or devices required by the Oklahoma Vessel and Motor  
8 Registration Act. Provided, that the Tax Commission may adjust any  
9 mailing costs as deemed appropriate to allow for increased or  
10 additional fees charged by the United States Postal Service.

11 Failure by any applicant to receive notification of renewal as  
12 provided by this section shall not excuse the applicant from  
13 properly obtaining any registration at the proper time by presenting  
14 proof of ownership to the Tax Commission's state office or to a  
15 motor license agent.

16 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
