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14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Physician  
16 Manpower Training Commission from any monies not otherwise  
17 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
18 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
19 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
20 the duties imposed upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission  
21 by law.

22 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the  
23 Physician Manpower Training Commission shall budget all funds in the  
24 following categories and amounts:

11 each budget category.

12 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
13 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
14 upon the Physician Manpower Training Commission by law shall be set  
15 by the Physician Manpower Training Commission. The salary of the  
16 Executive Director shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
17 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011.  
18 The Physician Manpower Training Commission for the fiscal year  
19 ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary  
20 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures  
21 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as  
22 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of  
23 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
