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13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Office
15 of the State Bond Advisor shall budget all funds in the following
16 categories and amounts:

21 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for

23 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
24 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

1 upon the Office of the State Bond Advisor by law shall be set by the
2 State Bond Advisor. The Office of the State Bond Advisor for the
3 fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following
4 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
5 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
6 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
7 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
