12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Election
14 Board from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General
15 Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June
16 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much
17 thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the
18 State Election Board by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the State
20 Election Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
21 and amounts:

5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
8 upon the State Election Board by law shall be set by the Secretary
9 of the State Election Board. The salary of the Secretary of the
10 State Election Board shall not exceed _____
11 Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year
12 ending June 30, 2011. The State Election Board for the fiscal year
13 ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the following budgetary
14 limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures
15 excluding expenditures for capital and special projects, except as
16 may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of
17 Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
