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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the
14 State Treasurer from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the
15 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year
16 ending June 30, 2011, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
17 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
18 upon the Office of the State Treasurer by law.

19 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, the Office
20 of the State Treasurer shall budget all funds in the following
21 categories and amounts:

5 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
6 each budget category.

7 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not
8 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
9 upon the Office of the State Treasurer by law shall be set by the
10 Office of the State Treasurer. The Office of the State Treasurer
11 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2011, shall be subject to the
12 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees
13 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
14 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
15 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
