13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma  
15 Conservation Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated  
16 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal  
17 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
18 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
19 imposed upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
21 Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall budget all funds in the  
22 following categories and amounts:

7       The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
8 each category.

9       SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
10 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
11 upon the Oklahoma Conservation Commission by law shall be set by the  
12 Oklahoma Conservation Commission. The salary of the Executive  
13 Director of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission shall not exceed  
14 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the  
15 fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Oklahoma Conservation  
16 Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be  
17 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
18 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
19 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
20 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
