12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
14 Corporation Commission shall budget all funds in the following  
15 categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
8 upon the Corporation Commission by law shall be set by the General  
9 Administrator. The salary of the General Administrator of the  
10 Corporation Commission shall not exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00)  
11 per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010.  
12 The Corporation Commission shall be subject to the following  
13 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and  
14 expenditures excluding direct expenditures for well plugging as  
15 authorized in Section 310 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma Statutes, pit  
16 closure as authorized in Section 140 of Title 52 of the Oklahoma  
17 Statutes, and remediation of sites as authorized in Section 353 of  
18 Title 17 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as may be authorized pursuant  
19 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
20 Statutes:
