13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of
15 Environmental Quality from any monies not otherwise appropriated
16 from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal
17 year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00)
18 or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed
19 upon the Department of Environmental Quality by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the
21 Department of Environmental Quality shall budget all funds in the
22 following categories and amounts:

13 the Executive Director of the Department of Environmental Quality.
14 The salary of the Executive Director of the Department of
15 Environmental Quality shall not exceed _____ Dollars
16 (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for the fiscal year ending June
17 30, 2010. The Department of Environmental Quality for the fiscal
18 year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following
19 budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees and
20 expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special
21 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of
22 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
