6 [ State Capitol - management and control of space in  
7 State Capitol Building - providing provisions -  
8 effective date ]

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2001, Section 15.1, as  
12 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 317, O.S.L. 2009 (73 O.S. Supp.  
13 2009, Section 15.1), is amended to read as follows:

14 Section 15.1 A. The Legislature shall have management and  
15 control of the following space in the State Capitol Building:

16 1. The space on the third, fourth, fifth and sixth floors;

17 2. The space in the basement that is occupied by the

18 Legislature on June 1, 1995;

19 3. Approximately six thousand nine hundred thirty-nine (6,939)

20 square feet of space in the west wing of the first floor that is

21 occupied by the Department of Libraries on June 1, 1995;

22 4. Approximately six thousand six hundred ninety-one (6,691)

23 square feet of space in the west wing of the basement that is

1 occupied by the Department of Libraries and the Department of  
2 Central Services on June 1, 1995;

3 5. Approximately three thousand seven hundred seventy (3,770)  
4 square feet of space in the west wing of the basement that is  
5 occupied by the Department of Central Services on June 1, 1995;

6 6. Approximately two thousand one hundred (2,100) square feet  
7 of space in the center of the basement that is occupied by the  
8 Department of Central Services and the Office of State Finance on  
9 June 1, 1995;

10 7. Approximately six hundred (600) square feet of space in the  
11 center of the basement that is occupied by the Department of Central  
12 Services on June 1, 1995;

13 8. Approximately two thousand three hundred one (2,301) square  
14 feet of space in the center of the basement that is occupied by the  
15 Department of Central Services on June 1, 1995;

16 9. Approximately twelve thousand five hundred sixty (12,560)  
17 square feet of space in the west wing of the first floor that is  
18 occupied by the Office of the Attorney General on June 1, 2001;  
19 provided, upon the Office of the Attorney General vacating such  
20 space, any renovations thereto shall be made in such a manner as to  
21 ensure preservation and maintenance of the cultural and historic  
22 integrity of the Capitol; and

23 10. Upon completion of the project authorized in Section 332 of  
24 this title, all space in the west wing of the second floor that is

1 occupied by the Supreme Court, all space in the north wing of the  
2 second floor that is occupied by the Court of Criminal Appeals and  
3 any other space in the State Capitol Building that is occupied by  
4 the appellate courts prior to relocation to the Wiley Post  
5 Historical Building; provided, the Supreme Court and the Court of  
6 Criminal Appeals shall continue to have access to the courtrooms and  
7 designated robing rooms located in the west and north wings of the  
8 second floor upon such occasions as the Chief Justice of the Supreme  
9 Court or the Presiding Judge of the Court of Criminal Appeals deems  
10 necessary and appropriate.

11 B. The authority of the Legislature to allot space may be  
12 delegated to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker  
13 of the House of Representatives. Each House of the State  
14 Legislature shall have the exclusive charge of the purchase, use,  
15 allotment, and disposition of its respective chambers, committee  
16 rooms, fixtures, furniture, supplies, and apparatus, and shall be  
17 responsible for the use and preservation of same. The provisions of  
18 this section shall not prohibit the Legislature from allowing  
19 agencies of the executive or judicial departments to use space  
20 within the State Capitol Building that is under its management and  
21 control.

22 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 73 O.S. 2001, Section 98.6, is  
23 amended to read as follows:

1 Section 98.6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
2 contrary, the ~~Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration~~  
3 ~~Commission~~ Legislature shall have the management and control of the  
4 following space in the State Capitol Building:

5 The four offices and all space in the approximately 1,000 square  
6 feet of space on the first floor in the area designated as room 105,  
7 using January 1, 2001, as the reference point.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
