7 An Act relating to the Department of Public Safety;
8 authorizing certain law enforcement officers to
9 obtain part-time law enforcement employment during
10 certain furlough period; providing for reinstatement
11 of certain restriction; providing for codification;
12 and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-105.4C of Title 47, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Any Highway Patrol officer or other law enforcement officer
18 employed as a full-time-equivalent (FTE) of the Department of Public
19 Safety and otherwise prohibited by law or Department policy from
20 obtaining part-time employment as a law enforcement officer with any
21 other law enforcement agency shall hereby be authorized to engage in
22 such part-time employment for the duration of any furlough period
23 imposed by the Commissioner of Public Safety or otherwise required
24 by law. Any previous restriction on such officers relating to
outside employment shall be reinstated no longer than two weeks

1 following the end of any furlough status as determined by the
2 Commissioner of Public Safety.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
