10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1681.1, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 1681.1 The Construction Industries Board shall
14 establish by rule a process for the formal review of the plans and
15 specifications for a project prior to bid dates for the project to
16 ensure that the project plans and specifications are in conformance
17 with applicable plumbing, electrical and mechanical installation
18 codes. The rule adopted by the Board shall provide that the review
19 shall be completed in a timely manner, not to exceed fourteen (14)
20 calendar days from the date of the submission of a completed
21 application for review which ~~is~~ shall be accompanied by the plans
22 and specifications and a review fee not to exceed Two Hundred
23 Dollars (\$200.00) to be established by the rule. Upon completion of
24 the review, the plans and specifications shall be returned to the

1 applicant with documentation indicating either approval of plans and
2 specifications ~~which are~~ when in compliance with the applicable
3 codes, or modifications which must be made to bring the plans and
4 specifications into conformance with applicable codes. Submission
5 of ~~such~~ the plans and specifications for review by the Board shall
6 be voluntary.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2010.

8 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
10 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
