11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Court of  
13 Criminal Appeals from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the  
14 General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year  
15 ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or  
16 so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed  
17 upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law.

18 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Court  
19 of Criminal Appeals shall budget all funds in the following  
20 categories and amounts:

23 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
24 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed

1 upon the Court of Criminal Appeals by law shall be set by the Judges  
2 of the Court of Criminal Appeals. The Court of Criminal Appeals,  
3 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, shall be subject to the  
4 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
5 and expenditures, except as may be authorized pursuant to the  
6 provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:
