11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7020 of Title 36, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 This act may be known and shall be cited as the "Oklahoma All
16 Payer All Provider Claims Database Act".

17 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7021 of Title 36, unless there
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. The Legislature recognizes the urgent need to provide health
21 care consumers, third-party payors, providers and health care
22 planners with information regarding the trends in use and cost of
23 health care services for improved decision-making. This is to be
24

1 accomplished by compiling a uniform set of data and establishing
2 mechanisms through which the data will be disseminated.

3 B. It is the intent of the Legislature to require that the
4 information necessary for a review and comparison of utilization
5 patterns, cost, quality and quantity of health care services be
6 supplied to the health care database by all providers of health care
7 services and third-party payors to the extent required by Section 4
8 of this act and this section. The Insurance Department shall
9 promulgate by rule the types of information which shall be submitted
10 and the method of submission.

11 C. The information is to be compiled and made available in a
12 form prescribed by the Department to improve the decision-making
13 processes regarding access, identified needs, patterns of medical
14 care, price and use of health care services.

15 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7022 of Title 36, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Insurance Department shall develop policy regarding the
19 collection of health care data pursuant to the Oklahoma All Payer
20 All Provider Claims Database Act.

21 B. The Department is authorized to share information and data
22 with Oklahoma universities as well as other state public agencies
23 for the purposes of conducting research, policy analysis and
24

1 preparation of reports describing the performance of the health care
2 delivery system from public, private and quasi-public entities.

3 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7023 of Title 36, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 A. The Insurance Department shall administer the health care
7 database. In administering the health care database, the Department
8 shall receive health care data from those entities identified in
9 Section 5 of this act and amendments thereto and provide for the
10 dissemination of such data.

11 B. The Department may contract with an organization experienced
12 in health care data collection to collect the data from the health
13 care payers and administrators identified in Section 5 of this act,
14 build and maintain the database. The Department may accept data
15 submitted by associations or related organizations on behalf of
16 health care providers by entering into binding agreements negotiated
17 with such associations or related organizations to obtain data
18 required pursuant to this section.

19 C. The Department shall promulgate rules governing the
20 acquisition, compilation and dissemination of all data collected
21 pursuant to the Oklahoma All Payer All Provider Claims Database Act.
22 The rules shall provide at a minimum that:

1 1. Measures have been taken to provide system security for all
2 data and information acquired under the Oklahoma All Payer All
3 Provider Claims Database Act;

4 2. Data will be collected in the most efficient and cost-
5 effective manner for both the Department and providers of data;

6 3. Procedures will be developed to assure the confidentiality
7 of patient records;

8 4. Users may be charged for data preparation or information
9 that is beyond the routine data disseminated and that the Department
10 shall establish by the adoption of such rules a system of fees for
11 such data preparation or dissemination; and

12 5. The Department will ensure that the health care database
13 will be kept current, accurate and accessible as prescribed by
14 rules.

15 D. Data and other information collected pursuant to the
16 Oklahoma All Payer All Provider Claims Database Act shall not be
17 disclosed by the Department or made public in any manner which would
18 identify individuals.

19 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7024 of Title 36, unless there
21 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The following entities shall file health care data with the
23 Insurance Department as prescribed by the Department:

24 1. State-regulated commercial group insurance plans;

1 2. Employer-sponsored plans; and

2 3. Third-party administrators.

3 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7025 of Title 36, unless there
5 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The Insurance Department shall make the data available to
7 interested parties on the basis prescribed by the Department and as
8 directed by rules of the Department.

9 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7026 of Title 36, unless there
11 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

12 The Insurance Department shall on or before February 1 each year
13 make a report to the Governor and the Legislature as to health care
14 data activity, including examples of policy analyses conducted and
15 purposes for which the data was disseminated and utilized, and as to
16 the progress made in compiling and making available the information
17 specified under the Oklahoma All Payer All Provider Claims Database
18 Act.

19 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
