7 An Act relating to elections; amending 26 O.S 2001,
8 Section 6-109, which relates to order of names on
9 ballot; requiring rotation of candidates' names on
10 ballots for school offices; allowing Secretary of the
11 State Election Board to suspend certain provisions;
12 and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 6-109, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 6-109. On all Primary and Runoff Primary Election
17 ballots and ballots for school offices, except absentee ballots, the
18 names of the candidates for each office shall be rotated in such a
19 manner that all candidates' names appear in each position on ~~said~~
20 the ballots an equal number of times. Provided, however, the names
21 of candidates for judicial, ~~school~~, city and town offices shall be
22 placed on the ballot according to lot. Provided further, the
23 Secretary of the State Election Board may suspend the provisions of
24 this section with respect to ballots for school offices if the

1 Secretary determines that such provisions are not technologically
2 feasible.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2012.
