7 An Act relating to cities and towns; amending 11 O.S.
8 2001, Section 14-108, which relates to codification
9 of municipal ordinances; modifying certain
10 requirement; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 11 O.S. 2001, Section 14-108, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 14-108. A. The governing body of a municipality may,
15 from time to time, authorize a codification of its ordinances. Such
16 a code may be kept up to date by use of a loose-leaf system and
17 process of amendment. In a code of municipal ordinances, the title,
18 enacting clauses and emergency sections may be omitted and temporary
19 and special ordinances and parts of ordinances may also be omitted.
20 Permanent and general ordinances and parts of ordinances which are
21 to be repealed by the code shall be omitted from the code. The
22 ordinances and parts of ordinances included in the code may be
23 revised, rearranged, renumbered, and reorganized into some
24 systematic arrangement. The governing body may publish in

1 connection with the code new matter, provisions of state law
2 relating to the municipality, a history of the municipality, the
3 history of the municipal government, the names of officials and
4 other informational matter as the governing body may decide. The
5 book or pamphlet containing the code may also contain an index and
6 forms and instructions as the governing body may decide.

7 B. At least ~~three copies~~ one copy of the code shall be kept in
8 the office of the municipal clerk for public use, inspection and
9 examination. The municipal clerk shall keep copies of the code for
10 distribution or sale at a reasonable price.

11 C. Notice of the publication of the code shall be in the manner
12 provided for publication by title of certain codes and ordinances in
13 subsection A of Section 14-107 of this title.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2010.
