12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Council on Law  
14 Enforcement Education and Training from any monies not otherwise  
15 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
16 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_  
17 Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform  
18 the duties imposed upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and  
19 Training by law.

20 SECTION 2. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the  
21 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall budget all  
22 funds in the following categories and amounts:

4 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for  
5 each budget category.

6 SECTION 3. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
7 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
8 upon the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training by law  
9 shall be set by the Director. The salary of the Director shall not  
10 exceed \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable monthly for  
11 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Council on Law  
12 Enforcement Education and Training for the fiscal year ending June  
13 30, 2010, shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on  
14 full-time-equivalent employees and expenditures excluding  
15 expenditures for capital and special projects, except as may be  
16 authorized pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of  
17 the Oklahoma Statutes:
