12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the Pardon
14 and Parole Board shall budget all funds in the following categories
15 and amounts:

16 <u>Category</u>	<u>Appropriation</u>	<u>Total</u>
17 Administrative Services	\$0.00	\$0.00

18 The agency shall develop outcome-based performance measures for
19 each budget category.

20 SECTION 2. The duties and compensation of employees, not
21 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed
22 upon the Office of the Pardon and Parole Board by law shall be set
23 by the Executive Director. The salary of the Executive Director
24 shall not exceed _____ Dollars (\$0.00) per annum, payable

1 monthly for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The Office of the
2 Pardon and Parole Board for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010,
3 shall be subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-
4 time-equivalent employees and expenditures, excluding expenditures
5 for capital and special projects, except as may be authorized
6 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the
7 Oklahoma Statutes:
